To the Students, Parents of Students & Employees of the St. Joseph School District:

Federal law requires that each school district in the state of Missouri prepare an annual progress report on all asbestos-related activities for the past calendar year. Our trained School District Operations employees have completed the required building inspections for 2015. All discrepancies found during our 6 month internal inspections have been corrected & a copy of the completed work request is on file in the asbestos Maintenance Plan at each school.

- Spring Garden and Robidoux –Asbestos abatement in association with the Air Conditioning projects
  - Performed by B&R Environmental Services and Demolition.
- Edison, Hyde and Lake also had AC work done and Edison was the only location where minimal abatement was completed.

- Several other small jobs were completed within our 6 month inspections @ various schools.
  - Performed by qualified internal maintenance staff
